REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO APPLY TO UPS
Application and a non-refundable \$200 application fee. Find application at "How to Enroll" on our website at www.ip.extension.ucsd.edu . NOTE: Do <u>not</u> pay the application fee or express mail fee by bank wire.
Proof of language proficiency: Please see information table below for language requirements according to UPS Track
Copy of transcripts in English for the two most recent years of academic studies with grading scale in English and grade point average (GPA). Overall grades must show <u>above-average to superior</u> academic achievement (top 10% of the majority of the student's classes).
List of 12 courses that you would be satisfied to take at UCSD or UCSD Extension per quarter, organized by quarter in you will attend more than one quarter. Courses are on a space-available basis and you will enroll into 12 units (3 courses). This helps ensure a satisfying academic experience at UCSD. For UCSD Extension courses visit "Areas of Study" at the Extension website www.extension.ucsd.edu
A one-page statement explaining your reasons for choosing UC San Diego for your study abroad.
Financial verification indicating proof of funds to cover full tuition, fees, and estimated living expenses (\$13,000 USD per quarter. U.S. law requires that we have this funding proof on file in order to issue the Form I-20 for the student visa).
